For example, when typing in "turkey," you can find the answers to these questions:

- What is the safest way to thaw a frozen turkey?
- How long can a thawed turkey remain in the refrigerator after thawing?
- What should I do if the turkey is done too soon?

ChemStation Sanitizer Options

ChemStation has been working hard to bring our customers sanitizer solutions that are effective, high quality, and meet rapidly changing market needs. We are pleased to share news that ChemStation has received EPA acceptance to add an emerging viral pathogen claim to the labels of several of our products from our EPA-registered quaternary ammonium compound and active ingredient line, under the CHEMSAN and CLEANSAN brands.

Meeting the EPA's criteria for effectiveness against emerging viral pathogens enables us to make off-label claims that CHEMSAN and CLEANSAN can fight SARS-CoV-2 which causes COVID-19 and future pathogens that may emerge. This represents the first group of our products submitted for emerging viral pathogen claims, with plans for more in the future.
