



Automated External Defibrillators (AED)

Many of us watched the Bengals-Bills Game on Monday, January 2nd where Damar Hamlin collapsed on the field after suffering from cardiac arrest, highlighting the urgency for immediate action and the use of AEDs. In September 2022, 53 employees at ChemStation Headquarters in Dayton OH participated in CPR/AED Training and new AED units were placed around our facility.

To minimize the time to defibrillation for cardiac arrest victims, deployment of AEDs should not be limited to only trained people (although training is still recommended).
